

ORDINANCE NO. 5764

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE,
CALIFORNIA PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION OF
COUNCILMEMBERS OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDALE:

SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS CREATED. The officers hereinafter designated in this ordinance are specifically provided for in The Charter of the City of Glendale.

SECTION 2. As to the persons in the classification of Councilmember, the increases or decreases in rates of compensation set forth in this ordinance shall be effective as provided under Section 8 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION RATES. The following schedule of compensation rates show standard salary range numbers, and the full-time monthly.

SECTION 4. CLASSIFICATION CODE AND COMPENSATION SCHEDULE. The code number and the salary range number assigned to each classification are as follows:

SECTION 5. PERS. The City reimburses Councilmembers for their PERS contributions.

**SECTION 6. PROVISIONS SIMILAR TO PRIOR SALARY ORDINANCE
-- CONSTRUCTION**

The provisions of this ordinance so far as they are substantially the same as the provisions of the former salary ordinance, and any amendment thereto, must be construed as continuations thereof and not as original enactments.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY OF PARTS OF ORDINANCE

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Council that the sections, paragraphs, lines, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence line, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, lines, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days following its adoption by Council. However, pursuant to the City Charter and Government Code Section 36516.5, increases to the salary of incumbent Councilmembers shall become effective upon the commencement of a new term of any Councilmember.
