The City of Glendale is not in a position to maintain the cemetery. Therefore, any activity that would alter or change the existing cemetery's condition is not allowed. Flowers or any other items left at the gravesite or elsewhere in the cemetery may be removed and will not be maintained. Please note that anything that you bring, you are responsible for taking with you upon departure. Thank you for your cooperation!

Hours:

Sundays Only

Front gate will open at 12:00 noon.

Front gate will close at 4:00 p.m.

* All persons shall enter and exit the cemetery through the public gate.

*Any person found on the grounds after the cemetery is closed (for any reason) will be cited for trespassing.

Permitted:

Bottled water for drinking

Cut flowers

*A minor must be accompanied by an adult

Not Permitted:

Bicycles or skateboard

Burials, interments, disinterments, inurnments, and removal of ashes are not permitted.

Animals

Firearms

Lighting of incense is prohibited.

Smoking

Candles or open flames

Food or beverages of any kind; except for water

Coolers/ice chests

Posting of advertisements or signs

Wreaths

Flower stands, urns, votive candles, iron work, fencing or other types of decorations shall not be allowed around any monument, grave, or crypt

Displays and/or sales of goods, wares, and/or merchandise

Structures, tents or awnings

Planting of shrubbery, plants, flowers or grass

Watering cans/instruments

*Access to buildings, including the Mausoleums, is not permitted until further notice
