Dear Resident, Business and Property Owner:

February 15, 2010

By this notification, the City of Glendale would like to inform you of the major construction activities that will be taking place over the next few weeks in connection with the Fairmont Avenue Extension project. These construction activities will have impacts on the traffic operations within San Fernando Road and Fairmont Avenue, and in turn on the nearby streets in the project area. Below is a listing of the upcoming major construction activities and their respective traffic impacts.

Bridge Decks Over San Fernando Road – Falsework Removals.

Construction Period:

February 15, 2010 through March 15, 2010.

Construction Activity:

The construction contractor has completed the placement of the concrete for the bridge decks which span over San Fernando Road and the railroad tracks. The removal of the falsework systems (temporary support structures for the construction of the bridge deck) has begun.

The construction contractor has completed the removal of the falsework system for the “Ramp Bridge” over San Fernando Road. The “Ramp Bridge” is the single-lane bridge component of the bridge system that spans over San Fernando Road.

The removal of the falsework system for the “Main Bridge” over San Fernando Road will be conducted in late February/ early March 2010. A total of five days is anticipated for this removal operation. The “Main Bridge” is the three-lane bridge component of the bridge system that spans over San Fernando Road.

It is important to note that the removal of the falsework system over the railroad tracks will be conducted following the removal of the falsework system over San Fernando Road. A separate notification to the community will be provided prior to commencement of this work.

Traffic Impacts:

The removal of the falsework for the “Main Bridge” will require full closure of San Fernando Road between Doran Street and Fairmont Avenue - between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. The removal of the falsework system is anticipated to take place during five consecutive days. During this period, San Fernando Road will be fully closed - this is for the safety of the traveling public and the construction crew.

Traffic detours will be provided to maintain through traffic on the nearby streets/arterials and provide access to State Route 134 freeway ramps and local streets. Signs will be installed within San Fernando Road in advance of the above closures of San Fernando Road to alert the public of the timing of the roadway closures.

Installation of Electric Vault within San Fernando Road.

Construction Period:

February 15, 2010 through March 15, 2010.

The City of Glendale's Water and Power Department will be installing a new underground electric vault within San Fernando Road, on the east side of the street, to the south of Doran Street. This work is in connection with the widening of San Fernando Road, between Doran Street and Fairmont Avenue, and is associated with the removal of a power pole at the intersection of San Fernando Road and Doran Street.

Traffic Impacts:

Lane closures on San Fernando Road, between Milford Street and Fairmont Avenue, will take place during the various stages of this work. Traffic detours will be provided to maintain through traffic on nearby streets/arterials and provide access to State Route 134 freeway ramps and local streets.

Construction of the Retaining Wall leading to the Bridge Abutment (End Support of the Bridge Structure) within Fairmont Avenue

Construction Period:

February 15, 2010 through March 15, 2010.

Construction Activity:

The work will be conducted with Fairmont Avenue – within the fenced area of the construction trailer at the southeast corner of the intersection of San Fernando Road and Fairmont Avenue. No night work is anticipated for this construction activity.

Traffic Impacts:

The work will be conducted away from public streets. There will be no significant traffic impacts due to this construction activity. The existing traffic lanes within San Fernando Road and Fairmont Avenue will be maintained.


City Contacts:
