Dear Resident, Business and Property Owner:

This notification is in regards to temporary street parking provided along Concord Street - between Fairmont Avenue and Doran Street - to accommodate the temporary parking needs of the residents and businesses fronting Fairmont Avenue and Concord Street during the upcoming construction activities within Fairmont Avenue and Concord Street. As noted on the City of Glendale's earlier notification, street parking on both sides of Fairmont Avenue - between Concord Street and the freeway ramps, and on Concord Street near the intersection of Fairmont Avenue and Concord Street - will be prohibited on the following dates:

Wednesday - June 9, 2010 - 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. The contractor will grind the existing asphaltic concrete pavement within Fairmont Avenue - between Concord Street and the freeway ramps.

Saturday - June 12, 2010 - 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. The contractor will construct rubberized asphalt pavement at the intersection of Concord Street and Fairmont Avenue, and within Fairmont Avenue - between Concord Street and the freeway ramps.

To address the temporary parking needs of the residents and businesses fronting Fairmont Avenue during the above construction, the City of Glendale will provide temporary street parking on Concord Street - on both sides of the street - between Fairmont Avenue and Doran Street. The impacted residents and the business owners on Fairmont Avenue and Concord Street may park their cars on Concord Street, against the red curb, between Fairmont Avenue and Doran Street on the following date:

- 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday June 8, 2010 until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday June 12, 2010



Traffic detours will be provided to maintain through traffic on major streets/arterials. Access to local businesses will be provided during all full street closures.
